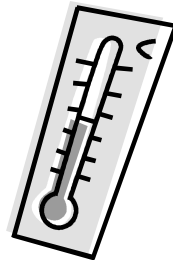


What's Your Temperature?

2. Why do you think our culture falls into the trap of feeling like things are great if you have material wealth?
3. Laodicea was a wealthy city (materialistically). Why, then, are they described as wretched, miserable, poor, blind, and naked?
4. What are some of the things that cause us to slip into complacency in our own lives?
5. How does it feel to know that complacency, or uselessness, actually makes God sick?
6. What are some things you can do to "change your temperature" and be made useful this holiday season?
